The salutatorian and valedictorian will be determined by their overall grade point average rounded to the nearest tenth of one percent.

In case of a tie for valedictorian, both students will be honored as co-valedictorians and no salutatorian will be recognized.

In case of a tie for salutatorian, both students will be honored as co-salutatorians in addition to the valedictorian.

Salutatorians and valedictorian students will be recognized with medallions to be worn at the commencement exercises.

Students earning a cumulative GPA of 3.71-3.89 will be honored and recognized as Magna Cum Laude.

Students earning a cumulative GPA of 3.90 and higher will be honored and recognized as Summa Cum Laude.

Magna Cum Laude and Summa Cum Laude students will be recognized with medallions to be worn at the commencement exercises.
