Graduation Requirement: LB 399

March 2019 the Unicameral passed LB399, impacting how often social studies curriculum would be reviewed by District Administration and the Board of Education. LB399 ensures that the district's curriculum aligns with state social studies standards and "teaches and assesses foundational knowledge in civics, history, economics, financial literacy and geography."

The Bill places requirements on school district's requirements to graduate to meet certain knowledge of civics. Hyannis Area Schools will require every graduating senior to attend a Board of Education meeting at least once prior to graduating and presenting an essay on their experiences and the Board proceedings to the Senior Class Sponsor.
