# MARCHING BAND



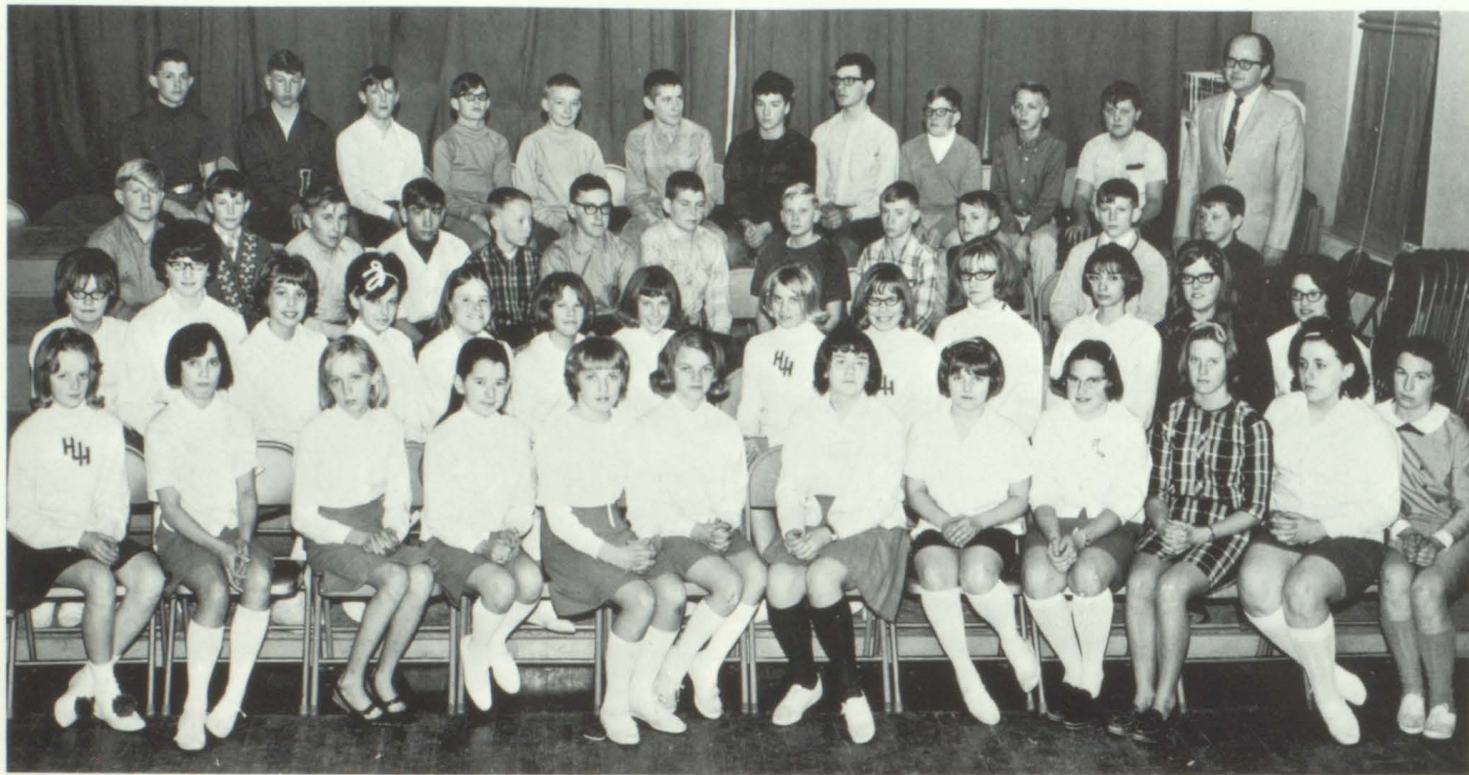
