Pep Band was a select group of players who played for basketball games. For the first year the Pep Band did a great job and was the best Pep Band in Western Nebraska.

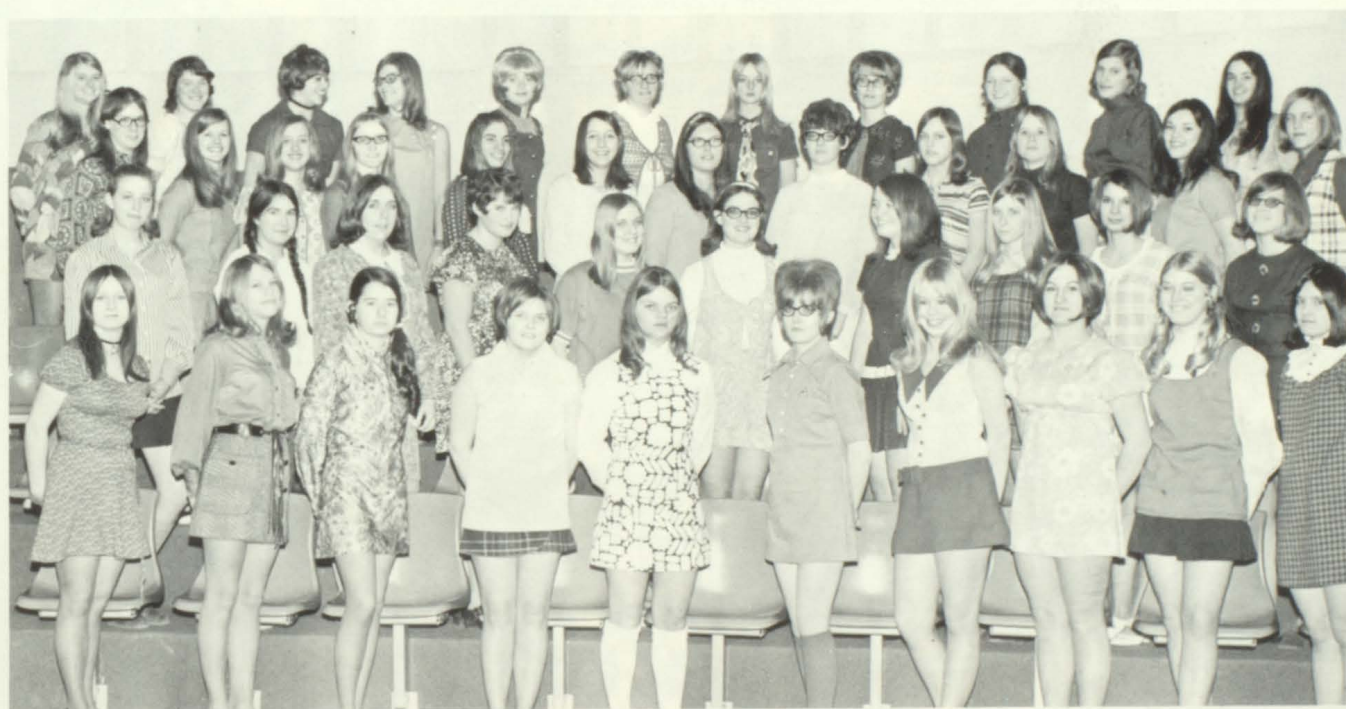
