This year's annual is not quite a creative masterpiece, but it has its moments. I hope that the student body enjoys this book, and that it recaptures some memories of the year 1977-78.

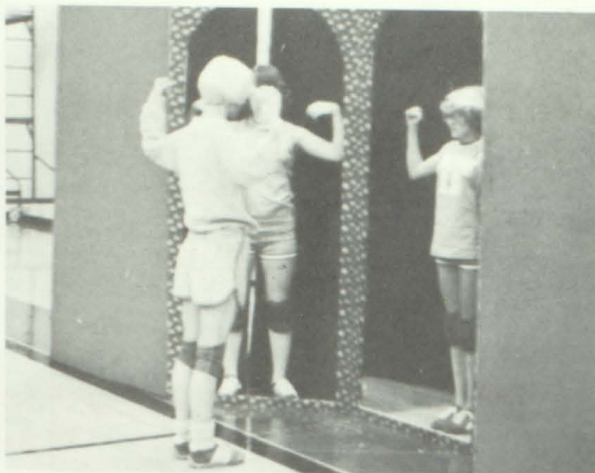

Longhorn Athletics . . . 77-78

If an athlete can come through a season with his pride intact, he has had a successful season. If this standard is used to judge the success or failure of athletic endeavor, then few at Hyannis High School have reason to be ashamed of their participation in sports during the 1977-78 school year. It is true that some of the won-lost records appear rather dismal in retrospect. It is also true, however, that there were enough bright spots in every sport to instill in each athlete a sense of pride in his participation in that activity. What follows is a brief summary of a year in which the only reward for many athletes was pride.

Homecoming was the highlight of the 1977 football season. Despite losing every other game of the season, the Longhorns, as a team, set three school records in their decisive victory over the Harrison Warriors. The team scored more points, rushed for more yards, and gained more total yards than any other Longhorn squad in history. Paul Cleveland won All-Conference honors, while Troy Dubs and Kevin Burton won honorable mention.

Autumn 1977 proved to be fruitful for the Hyannis volleyball team as it posted a winning record and carted off a raft of individual honors in both the Panhandle and Sandhills Conferences. The Longhorns were led by Kayla Zickefoose, who won All-Conference honors in both the Panhandle and Sandhills Conferences. Katrina Spencer, Peg Vinton, and Jill Shepherd were also awarded Panhandle Conference honors, while Jecca Frye received honorable mention in the Sandhills Conference.

Although the boys basketball season was something of a disappointment in terms of the record compiled by the team, the participants put a good deal of effort into the season. Kevin Burton, who won All-Conference honors in the Panhandle and Sandhills Conferences, and Lyndon Branson were the Seniors on a team laden with underclassmen. Among the Juniors and Sophomores Jack Connealy, Tim Lenz, Dean Haney, Chancy Groves, Clark Jeary, Jay Haney, and Doug Sutton gave Hyannis fans reason to be optimistic about the future.

Four girls found themselves named to All-Conference squads as the basketball season reached its conclusion. Miki Simpson and Kayla Zickefoose, who made All-Conference in the Sandhills and Panhandle Conferences, led the 'Horns to a winning season. In addition to Kayla and Miki, Jecca Frye was selected for Panhandle All-Conference honors.

Wrestling was perhaps the brightest spot in Hyannis High School athletics during the 1977-78 school year. The team and individual team members consistently placed high at tournaments. The season culminated at Lincoln, where H.H.S. finished eighth in the state tournament. Those wrestlers who attended state tournament were led by Jay Dubs, who placed first in the 98 pound division. Dave Yaune placed second in the 119 pound division. Roy Westover finished his high school wrestling career by winning fourth place in the 167 pound division. Also attending the state tournament was Tracy Spencer, who did not place.

Kevin Burton and Jack Dredla led the boys track team by qualifying for the state track meet in the pole vault. In addition to going to state Kevin and Jack helped the 880 relay team set a school record. Jack Connealy and Dean Haney were the other members of the 880 relay team. Jay Haney contributed to the season by setting a record in the triple jump. Dave Yaune's time in the high hurdles was also a school record.

The highlight of the girl's track season came when the two mile relay team set a Sandhills Conference record with a time of eleven minutes and eighteen seconds. Jennifer Runner set a record in Hay Springs by clocking a six minute eighteen second mile. Miki Simpson set Hyannis High School records in the 220 and 440. The track team also had outstanding 440 and 880 relay teams.

As these accomplishments indicate, Longhorn athletes can be proud of the 1977-78 sports year.

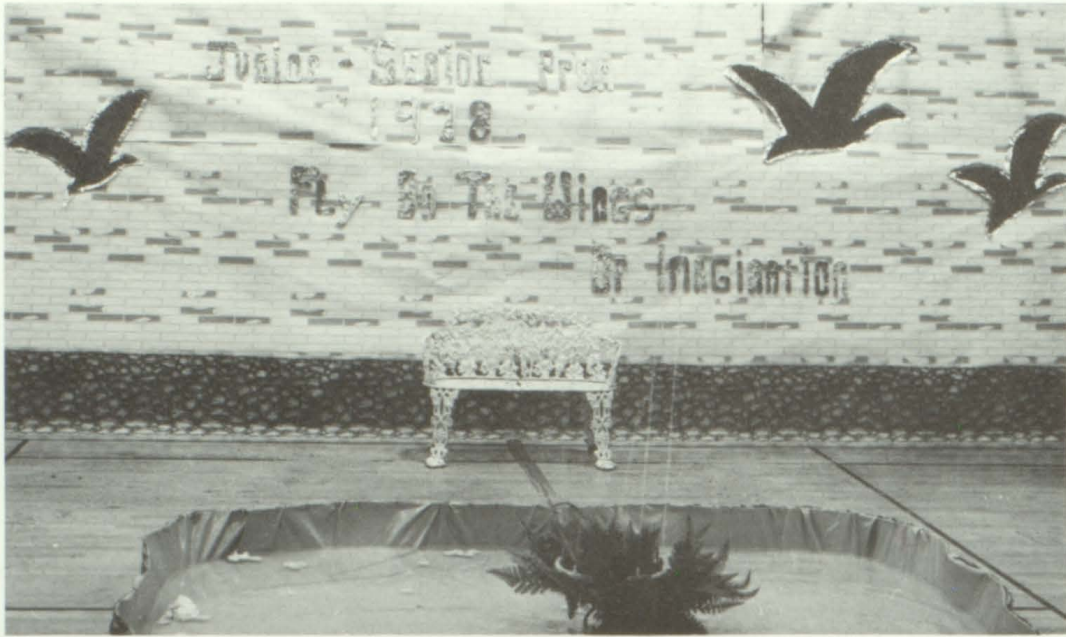
