Miss Tolstedt, was a new teacher, who had an active job in the Art Department. She also taught 7th grade English.



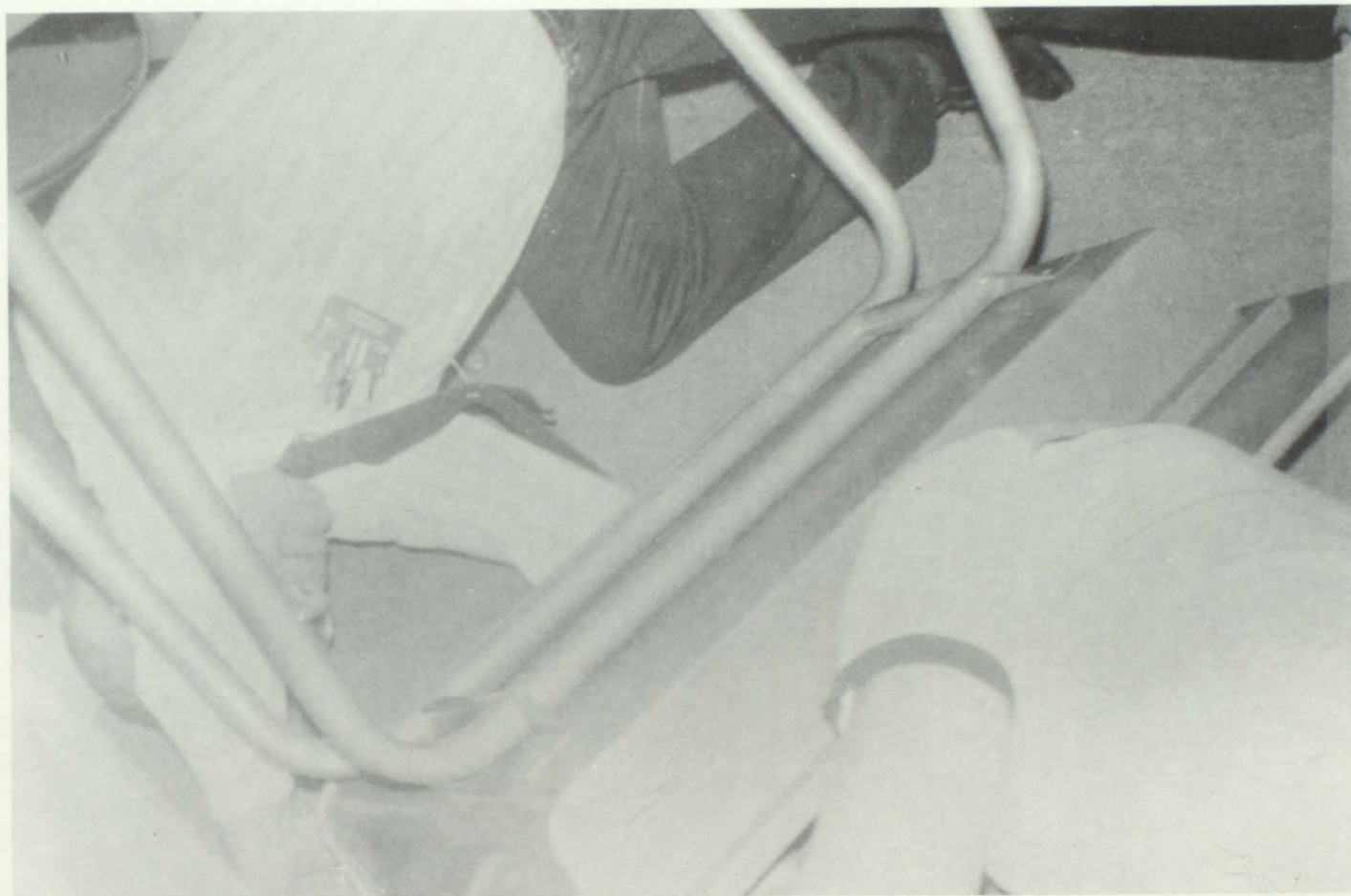

Hyannis athletes displayed this ability in every sport this year.

The Hyannis girls, while not being as successful as they were last year, turned in performances which no one should have been ashamed of. After losing the nucleus of outstanding volleyball, basketball, and track squads to graduation, the girls turned in seasons of which they can all be proud.

The greatest improvement this year was shown in boys' athletics. The football team showed a complete reversal in last year's form by completing a very successful season. In basketball the boys got back on the winning track after a disappointing 1977-78 season. The wrestling team had the greatest success of all Hyannis teams, taking seven wrestlers to the state tournament and finishing fourth in that event. The boys' track team finished the season on a positive note as Dean Haney qualified for state in the pole vault.

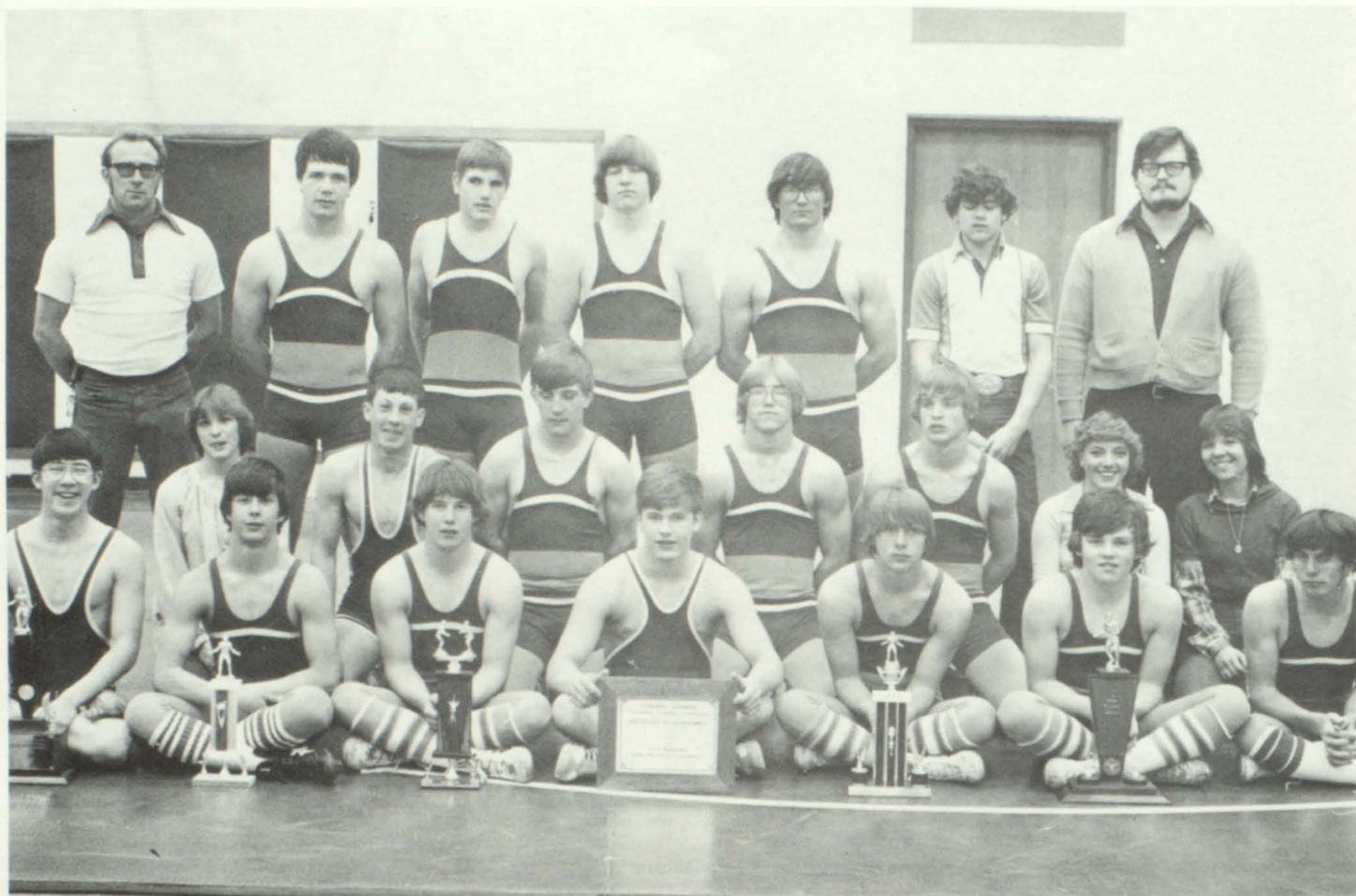
