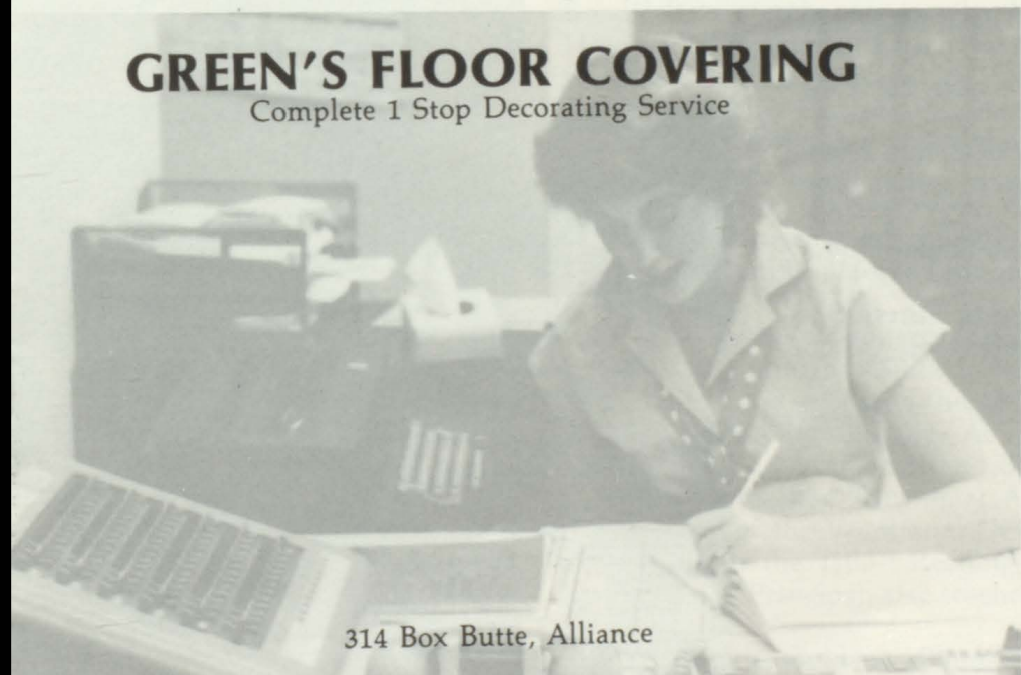

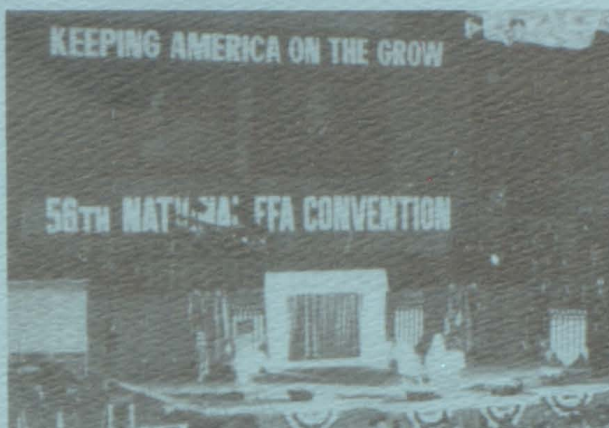

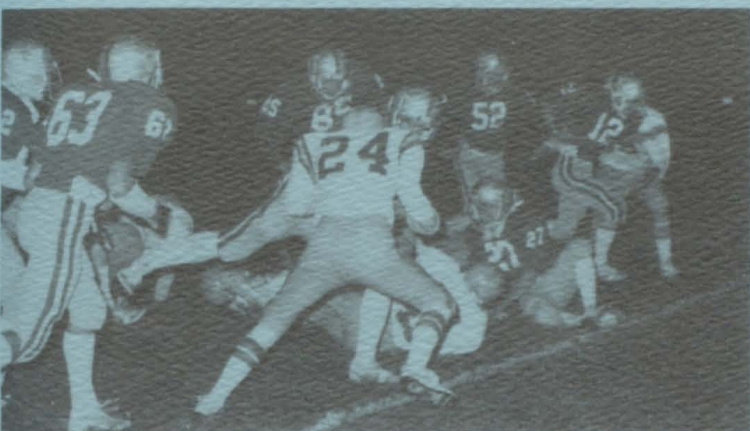

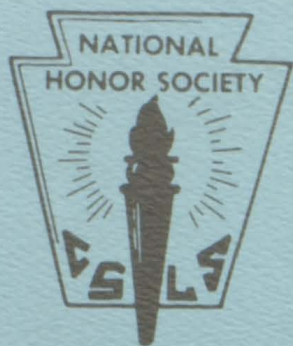

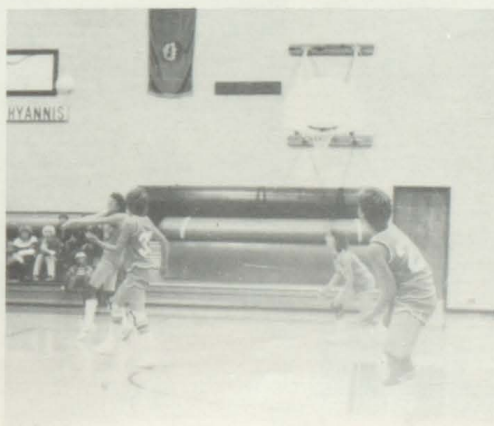

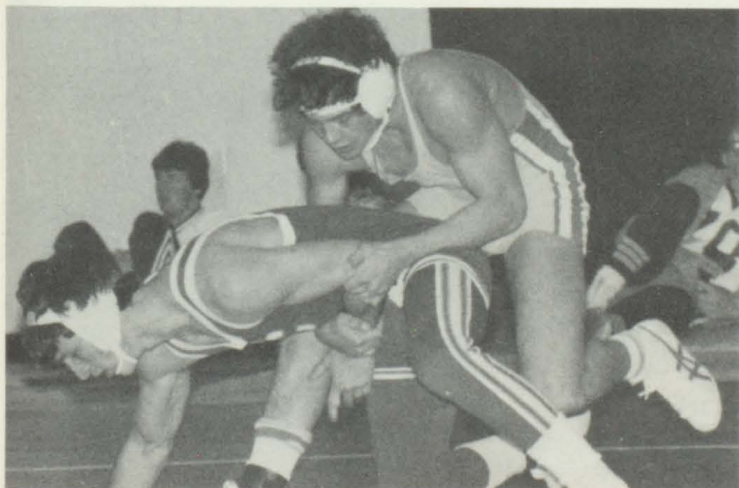

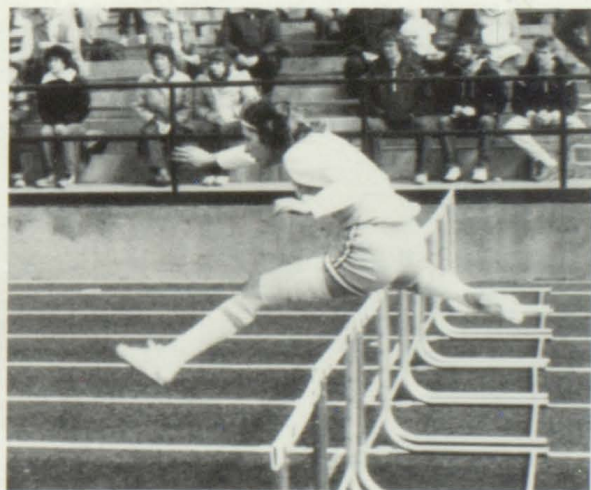

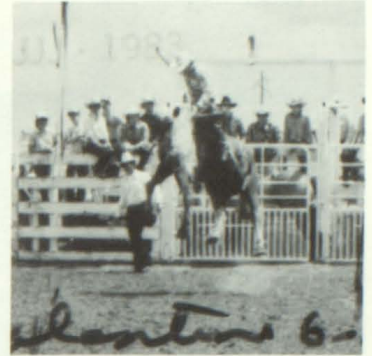

"DIRGE" ONE-ACT PLAY

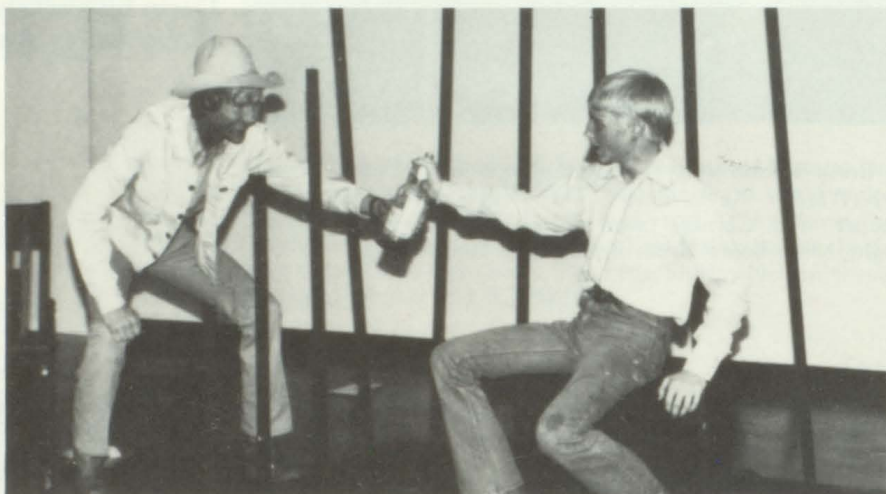
