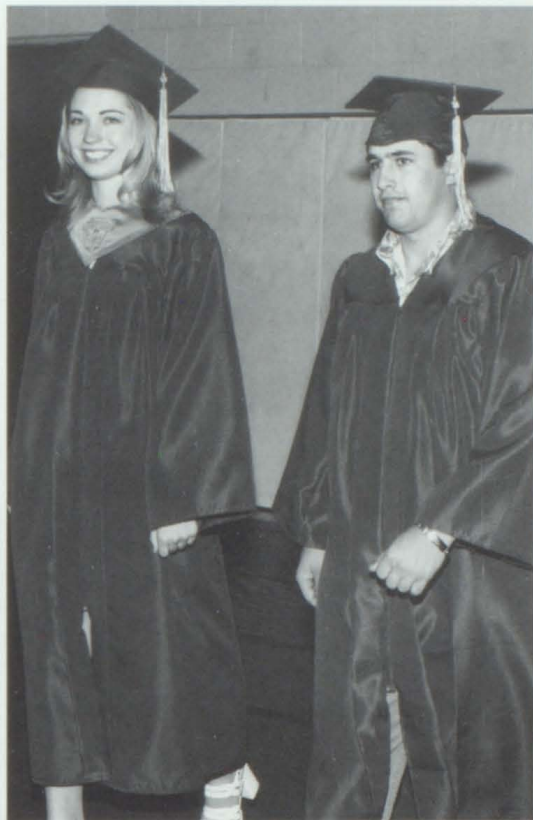


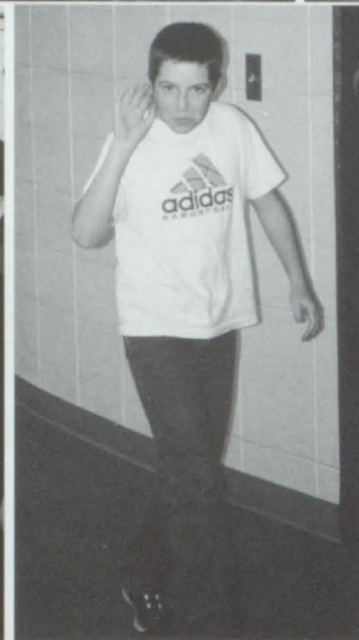
Graduates Prepare For

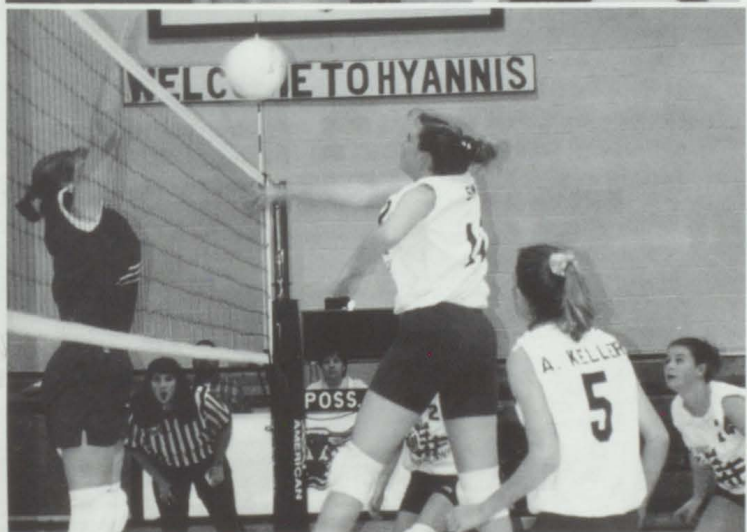
Volleyball Team Has A Competitive Year

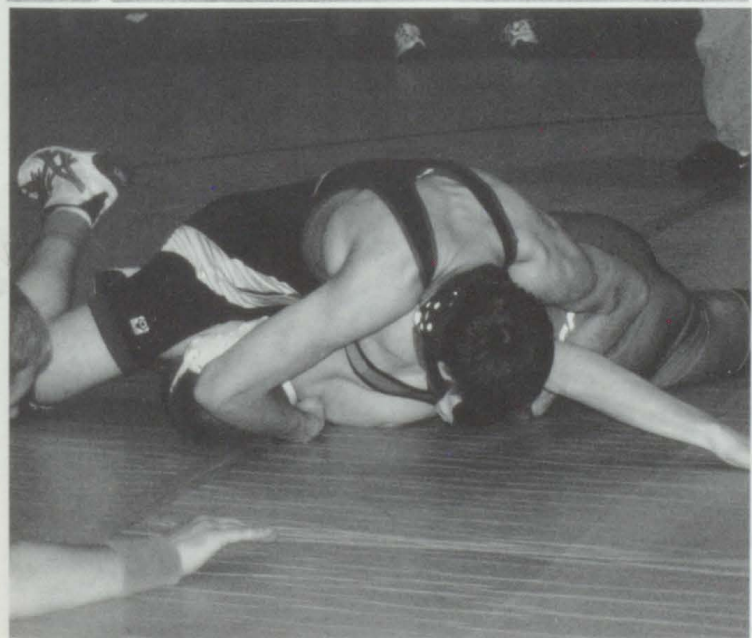
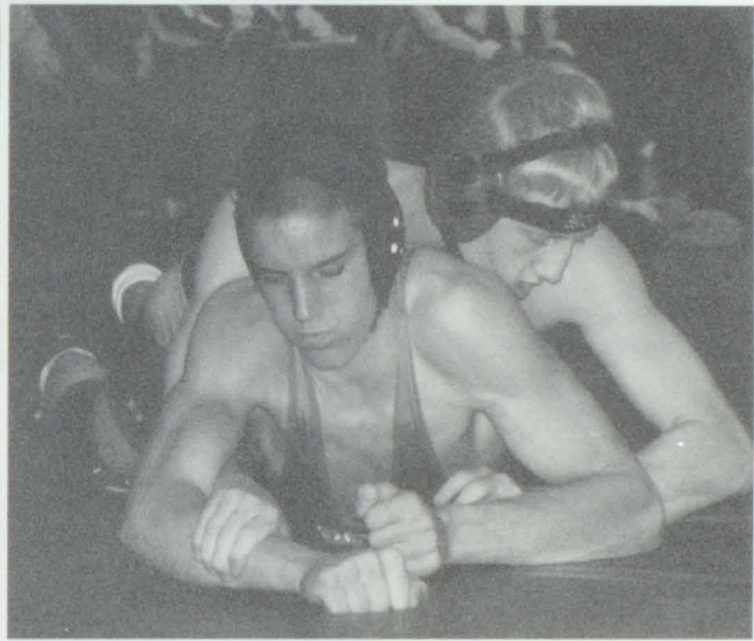
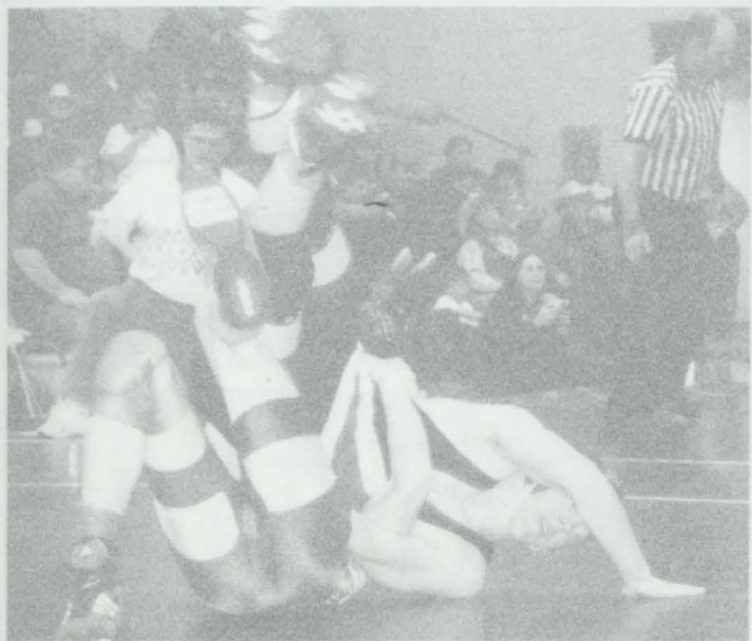


Wrestling Team Of 1999 -

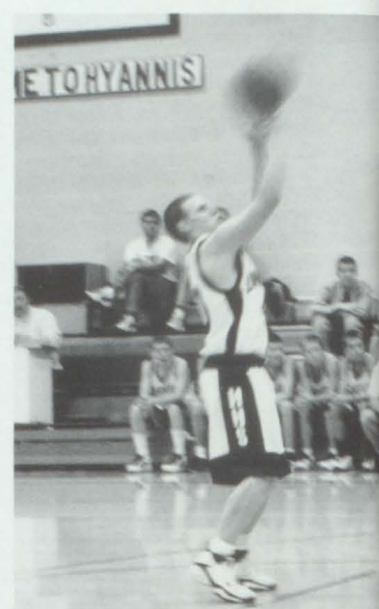

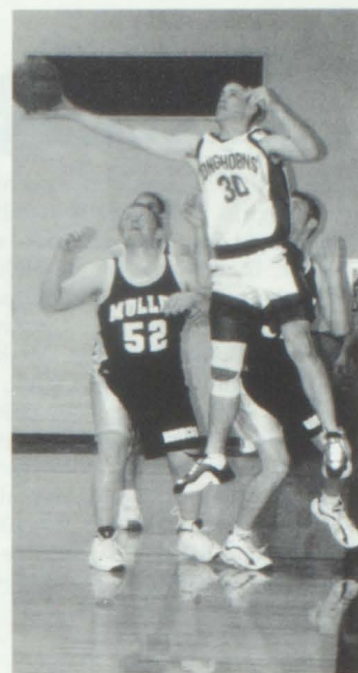
HS Boys End Season at Sub-Districts

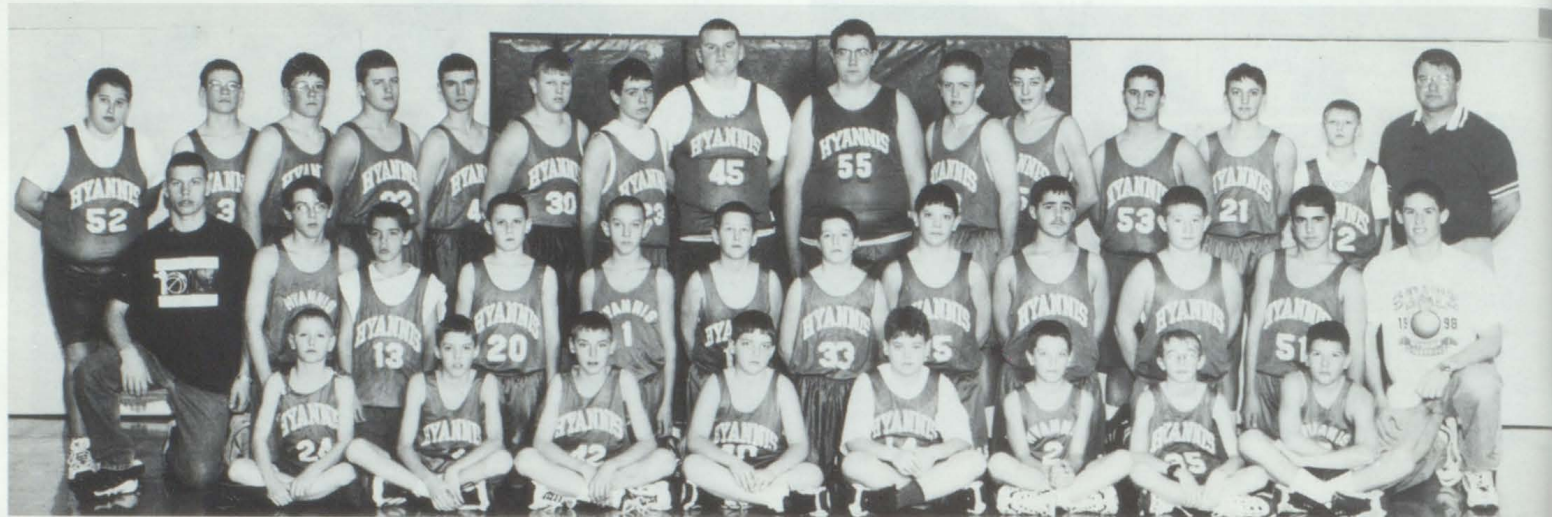

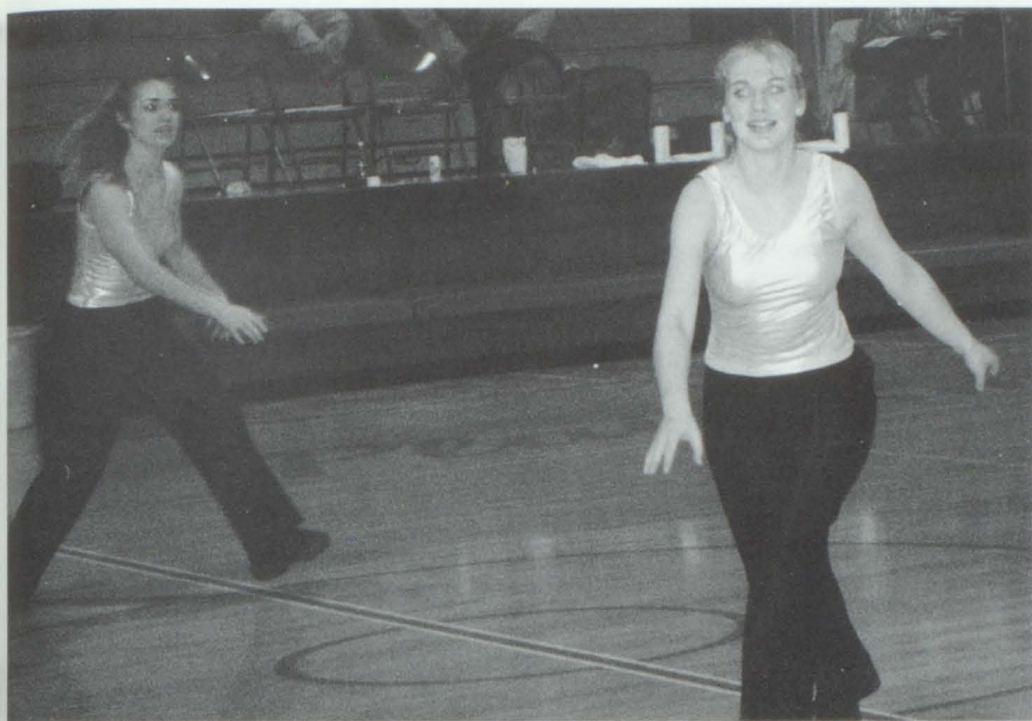

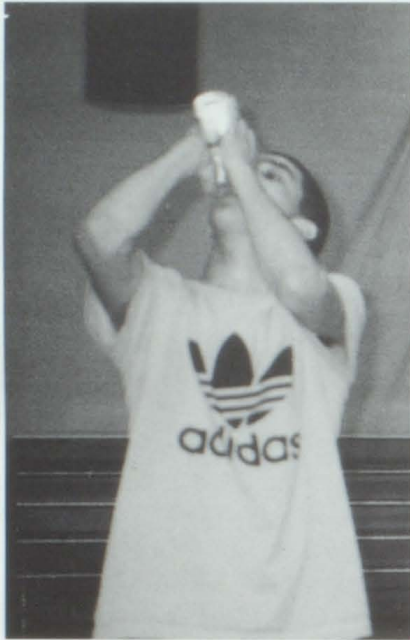

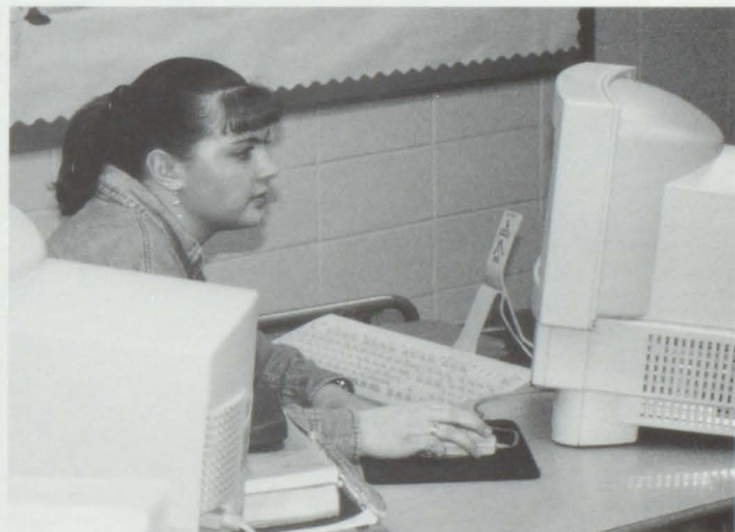

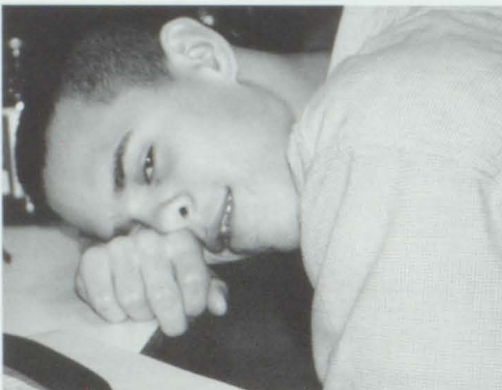
